Comments should have between 1000 and 3000 words. All manuscripts must be prepared in accordance with the style guidelines of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association (APA), 6th edition. Provide five keywords.

Submission Procedure

All contributions should be submitted electronically by email to the editorial team (editors@oneducation.net) in Word DOC, RTF, TXT or similar format. All submissions receive an initial editorial review. Comments will be assessed on their relevance, quality, and moral decency. The editorial team reserves the right to reject comments. For contributions considered for publication a PDF of the proofs will be sent by email to the corresponding author. Any accompanying queries should be answered as soon as possible so that publication is not delayed. Accepted contributions will be assigned a DOI and will be both available for download as pdf-version and can be read online.
